TOOLS

Wendy suggests you bring the following tools or you can buy the basics ribs, knives, shapers etc. in the studio.

- Variety of tools to draw in to the clay with like sewing needles, wooden BBQ skewer.
- Metal kidney (rib).
- Fine sponge (makeup sponges are good).
- Sharp craft knife.
- Potters knife.
- Wide and fine brushes.
- Scissors.
- A few natural or man made objects to press in to clay.
- An image to use with the different techniques.
- Notebook and pencil.

Please make sure any sharp or metal tools are in your stowed luggage NOT in your carry on bags.
